WHAT MAKES A GLOBAL GRANT APPLICATION SUCCESSFUL?

Our grant system empowers members to design projects with lasting benefits for communities. Consult with local experts early in the planning process to build a strong project plan and global grant application. Your application needs to clearly describe how your project, scholarship, or vocational training team:

- Responds to real community needs
- Aligns with one of Rotary's areas of focus
- Actively involves Rotary members and community members
- Meets the eligibility requirements in the grant terms and conditions
- Includes measurable goals
- Will be sustainable and successful long after the global grant funds have been spent
